Seminole Nation of Oklahoma Indian Community Development Block Grant ARP Act

The Housing Authority of the Seminole Nation of Oklahoma (HASNOK) will accept comments from the public:

Monday, August 16, 2021 – Friday, August 27, 2021

to consider an Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) ARP Act application to the United States Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD).

Up to \$1,035,000 is available on a competitive basis for COVID-19 housing, public facilities and infrastructure, and public service projects to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19. Funding is available to any Indian Tribe or Alaska Native Village. The projects presented on behalf of the Seminole Nation of Oklahoma include:

- I. Rehabilitation of HASNOK rental housing to improve health, safety, and ventilation to reduce risks of COVID-19
- II. New Construction of two tiny homes to reduce overcrowding to prevent and respond to COVID-19
- III. Rehabilitation to privately owned homes to improve health, safety, and ventilation to reduce risks of COVID-19
- IV. Expanding cell towers and broadband infrastructure capacity to assist rural HASNOK communities
- V. Rehabilitation of HASNOK administrative office to improve health, safety, and ventilation to reduce risks of COVID-19
